



Partnership Agreement between Parents, Students and the College

AS A PARENT, I AGREE TO:

- ensure that my child attends College regularly, punctually, properly equipped and in correct uniform every day
- inform the College if my child will be late or will not be attending, and state the reason
- inform the College of any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour

- respond promptly to any complaints and involve parents in the development of a complaints procedure
