To Parents of Year 8, 9 and 10 students.

Dear Parents,

I am writing to inform you about the proposed “Easter 2011 Snowboarding Tour”. This tour will take place during the period Friday 8<sup>th</sup> April to Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> April 2011 (the Easter holiday).

The tour will be organised by a widely recognised school snowboarding Trip Company. The skiing trips of the past two years have been successful and we’re confident snowboarding will even exceed these. We used ‘PGL’ last year and the trip was excellent, so we may take them up on their offer but we have received competitive quotes elsewhere if we can secure certain numbers of students.

The tour cost includes the following:

6 day snowboarding in resort, including snowboard and boots hire.

6 day lift pass.

6 days of snowboarding instruction – 4 hours per day.

Accommodation and full board meal arrangements as specified.

Executive coach travel, ferry and road tolls.

Winter sports insurance, including ski breakage insurance.

Snow guarantee.

The resort will be in Austria, to be finalised once numbers of students that are interested has been established.

The cost of the tour will be £750 per student. This includes everything above, but does not include spending money or specialist ski clothing, for which we will organise a hire company.

As this is a lot of money, I am asking that you pay two initial deposits, one of £100 by the 22<sup>nd</sup> of July and a further £150 by the end of September 2010. The first deposit is non-refundable. After this there will be a monthly contribution of £100 until February 2011.

The final payment will have to be made by the end of February 2011; there are interim payments from the first two deposits right through until the final payment.

The non-refundable deposit of £100 has to be paid to the college by **Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2010** with the reply slip.

If you would like any more details about the tour please ring me at the college.

In order for this trip to take place we need to collect voluntary contributions to cover the costs incurred. We recommend the total contribution of £750. In the unlikely event that not enough contributions are collected it may prove necessary for the College to cancel the trip.
